Dear Professor O'Kane,
May I respectfully suggest the follow about this review?

It is inadequate in its very inception as it covers only CSG when it needs to cover all unconventional gas activities, including CSG.

There is an urgent need for the following:
Independent scientific research to establish baseline data against which to assess the health of people, domestic animals, soil, air and water, before allowing the continuation of this run away industry in NSW. This would require a total moratorium on all unconventional gas activity.

All areas of agricultural and other food production, water catchments, national parks and other natural environments essential to a healthy tourism industry, be designated off limits to unconventional gas mining.

That a minimum exclusion zone of five kilometres, free of all unconventional gas activities, extend around all clusters of housing and of two kilometres around all dwellings.
